



How much are the entry fees?

One Day - \$100
One Day with Garage - \$150
Two Day - \$125
Two Day with Garage - \$200

Garages are currently sold out. Please consult wait list should one become available.

Are there any special meals planned for participants?

Yes, there will be a BBQ for participants on Friday night. Tickets are available through the entry, or by calling the office. A select number will be available on-site during the event, however, we strongly recommend you purchase them in advance to ensure availability.

How much are the spectator tickets?

Friday Adult - \$7

Where can tickets be purchased?

Registration for participants and the ticket office for spectators will both be located at the Guest Registration building.

When time do we open to participants and spectators?

Friday & Saturday – 7am

When do we anticipate the events to end?

Friday – 6:00pm
Saturday – 5:00pm

Are they racing?

The last sessions, which will begin at 5pm on Friday, and 6pm on Saturday, will feature racing for select groups. Other than that, the groups are just making laps with their cars. This is exhibition-style, not competitive.

When and where will fuels be available?

At the Sunoco fuel station next to the garage, Super Unleaded 93, 260GTX 98 unleaded, 110 leaded and Supreme 112 will be available. An attendant will be at the pumps from 9am-1pm on Friday, and 8am-12pm on Saturday. Ethanol will be available for sale during these times only.

Fuel will be available around the clock with a credit card.

Are there any special fan events?

Yes. There will be a Classic (pre-2000) Car Show set up in the T4 area of the road course from 10am – 2pm. This will not be a judged car show, but a fan's pick.

The paddock will also be open for folks to wander through. The Norwood Arena Pace Car, as well as other vendors will be on display in the pit area.

Saturday is also setup day for the Swap Meet for the Inaugural Thompson Vintage Motorcycle Classic.

Where can one get food?

Dunkin Donuts will be on site, beginning at 7am both days.

Concession stands are open in the A Paddock on Friday from 11am-5pm and on Saturday from 9am-5pm.

The Raceway Restaurant is open daily beginning at 11:00am.

Where does the media go?

There are no specific requirements for the media.

The media center will be located in the second level of the road course control tower.

Where do photographers park?

Any photographer with the proper photo credential may park in the paddock. We would request that they park behind the Armco along the frontstretch of the road course on the grass.

Where do individuals picking up guest or press credentials go?

All credentials will be issued through the Guest Registration at the track entrance.

Where can staff park?

Staff will park behind the Armco along the frontstretch of the road course on the grass.

Are special credentials required to park in the paddock?

Yes, only those with a vehicle parking pass may park in the paddock, unless photographers or staff.

Are special credentials required to park camp?

Yes. Those will be issued out of guest registration. Only those who have reserved in advance, and who have a Camping Pass will be permitted to stay overnight.

Can one rent transponders?

This is not a timed event.
