DETERMINING THE STARTING LINEUP

Heat race lineups will be determined using current 2017 Championship Driver Standings. The registered driver with the lowest point total will start p. 1 in the first heat race. The registered driver with the second lowest point total will start p. 1 in the second heat, and so on until all registered drivers have a starting position. Any driver not participating in the immediately preceding event will start last in their respective heat.

A predetermined number of drivers – based upon car count (Five per heat race if less than fifteen cars. Six per heat race if sixteen or more cars) - will be entered into the handicap system. The driver with the lowest season point total coming into the event will start p. 1 in the feature. The driver with the second lowest season point total coming into the event will start p. 2 and so on until all drivers in the handicap positions have a starting spot. Drivers missing the immediately preceding event will be not be allowed to keep their handicap position. They will be required to start behind the point leader, but before cars failing to finish in a handicap position. Cars not qualifying for the handicap will be lined up based upon heat results.

GENERAL RULES & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

This event will be run in accordance with the 2017 Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park Limited Sportsman Division Rules, the information disseminated on this form, and any special rules applicable to the event and any amendments thereto. In the event of any conflict between the three, TSMP's judgment and interpretation will be final.

All drivers must be fifteen (15) years of age and have a valid 2017 NASCAR Whelen All-American Series Charger Division (or above) license that has not been suspended or revoked. All car owners must have a valid 2017 NASCAR Whelen All-American Series license that has not been suspended or revoked.

All cars must be safety inspected and receive a competition sticker before they will be permitted to participate in any on-track activity.

All scoring will be done by transponder. Transponder must be mounted in accordance with the diagram in Exhibit 2 of the Limited Sportsman Division Rules. Transponders are required to be on the cars at all times.

All teams must monitor the race control frequency during all non-track activity. The frequency being used will be available at the Handicapper's Building.

All engine fluids, lubricants, solvents and fuels must be disposed of in a proper manner in accordance with track rules and procedures and all other applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

All racecars must display the following logos:

(1) NASCAR Whelen All-American Series logo in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram

- (2) Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram
- (3) American Racer in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram
- (4) Sunoco Race Fuels in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram
- (5) All required NASCAR Whelen All-American Series decals in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram.
Decals must be on the racecar in order to receive consideration.
