HOOSIER TIRE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 43rd ANNUAL ICEBREAKER

The size and compound numbers are as follows:

Left 26.0/13.0-15 M30

Right 27.0/13-15 M450

The maximum tire allotment for this event is eight (8) inventoried tires per car number. All tires used for qualifying and the race must be purchased at the track and in the team's inventory, unless approved by the Divisional Inspector. Sunoco Modified Teams are required to register their inventoried tires with the Tire Inventory Manager. All tires must be inventoried at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the posted start time for qualifying. Tires used to start the feature race must be the same tires that were used to qualify.

DETERMINING THE STARTING LINEUP

Heat race lineups will be determined by a draw at sign-in. The driver drawing the lowest number will start p. 1 in the first heat race. The driver drawing the second lowest number will start p. 1 in the second heat, and so on until all registered drivers have a starting position.

Qualifying heats will determine feature race starting position. The starting lineup for the feature will be heads up from the qualifying finishing order. The winner of the first heat will start in p. 1 in the feature. The winner of the second heat will start p. 2, and so on until all drivers have a starting position.

GENERAL RULES & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

This event will be run in accordance with the 2017 Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park (TSMP) Sunoco Modified Division Rules, the information disseminated on this form, and any special rules applicable to the event and any amendments thereto. In the event of any conflict between the three, TSMP's judgment and interpretation will be final.

All drivers must be sixteen (16) years of age and have a valid 2017 NASCAR Whelen All-American Series Feature Division (or above) license that has not been suspended or revoked. All car owners must have a valid 2017 NASCAR Whelen All-American Series license that has not been suspended or revoked. Anyone wishing to gain access to pit road must have a valid NASCAR Whelen All-American Series license that has not been suspended or revoked, and be issued a pit road armband.

All cars must be safety inspected and receive a competition sticker before they will be permitted to participate in any competitive on-track activity.

All scoring will be done by transponder. Transponder must be mounted in accordance with the diagram in Exhibit 2 of the Sunoco Modified Division Rules. Transponders are required to be on the car at all times.

All teams must have a spotter – present in the spotter's stand – for all qualifying and feature races. All spotters must have radio communication with his/her driver and have the car number of the driver they are spotting for clearly indicated on the earcuff. All spotters must scan the TSMP radio frequency during all on track activity. The frequency being used will be available at the Handicapper's Building.

All engine fluids, lubricants, solvents, fuels and trash must be disposed of in a proper manner in accordance with track rules and procedures and all other applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

All racecars must display the following logos:

- (1) NASCAR Whelen All-American Series logo in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram
- (2) Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram
- (3) Hoosier Tire in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram
- (4) Sunoco Race Fuels Roof Decal
- (5) All required NASCAR Whelen All-American Series decals in accordance with the contingency sticker diagram.
Decals must be on the racecar in order to receive consideration.
