

THOMPSON VINTAGE MOTORCYCLE CLASSIC

RULES

Drivers will be broken up into 3 groups

- Group A - Advanced
- Group B - Intermediate
- Group C – Novice

Drivers may be moved from one group to another by event organizers in the interest of safety.

Safety Requirements

- Must be 16 years old. Minors must be accompanied by a guardian, who must complete minor release.
- 1 or 2 piece protective riding suit allowed. Must be leather or textile
- Full mesh suits are not allowed. Only back of the suit can be mesh
- If two piece top and bottom must zip together. Does not have to be a 360 degrees zip
- Full face helmet - Snell, DOT or equivalent approval. Recommend the helmet be no older than 5 years old.
- Full length non mesh, Leather motorcycle gloves. Gauntlet style Gloves
- over the ankle foot wear required. Motorcycle or riding boots recommended. Work boots are not permitted
- If safety gear has knee or toe glides they must be plastic or leather. No sparking type sliders allowed

Tech Requirements

- Minimum of 50% left to brake pads
- Should be able to see the wear indicators in the tires
- Throttle must return smoothly and fast
- Check to make sure there is no fluid leaks
- All glass and plastic must be taped over (except for the tach, speedometer, and face shield)
- Mirrors must be removed or taped over
- Headlight and brake lights must be disconnected
- If license plate is on the bike, make sure there are no sharp edges. If sharp edges are found, it must be taped
- Cameras & other electronics are allowed. Body and helmet cameras are not permitted
